

PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR SERVICE BY SPECIAL ORDER OF THE COURT

NOW COMES Plaintiff, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., ("Plaintiff"), by and through its attorneys, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., pursuant to 735 ILCS 5/12-203.1, requesting service by special order of the court in the above-referenced action, and in support of the herein motion, states as follows:

- 1. That the Plaintiff filed its Complaint for the herein case against Defendant Roger Romanelli ("Defendant") on September 9, 2023.
- 2. That, on October 17, 2023, the Sheriff of Cook County attempted unsuccessfully to serve the Defendant, stating he had moved. A copy of the non-service notice from the Cook County Sheriff's website is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 3. On November 13, 2023, Judge Maria M. Barlow entered an order appointing Gary Olson ("Olson") as Special Process Server. A copy of said Order is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 4. From November 13, 2023 to December 11, 2023, Olson conducted skip tracing and other investigations, attempting to locate the whereabouts of the Defendant.
- 5. After locating one address in downtown Chicago, the attempt to serve the Defendant there was unsuccessful in that the address turned out to be a UPS store where the Defendant purportedly had rented a mailbox. Olson's Affidavit of Non-Service dated December 11, 2023 detailing the unsuccessful attempt is attached as Exhibit C.

- 6. Olson conducted further investigation, conducting additional skip tracing and located an address for the Defendant at 4406 Madison Street in Hillside, Illinois ('the Hillside address'). The skip trace confirmed this address as the Defendant's residence.
- 7. Olson also found a car parked in the driveway at the Hillside address. Running a trace of the Illinois license plate number on this car in the driveway, Olson discovered it is registered to the Defendant.
- 7. Olson further located a phone number for the Defendant in a skip trace. After further attempts at service to the Defendant by knocking on his door, and observing the Defendant's car in the driveway and lights on inside the residence, Olson called the Defendant on March 25, 2024. He spoke with a male who identified as the Defendant, and who used several curse words directed to Olson before hanging up.
- 8. From March 24 through April 13, 2024, Olson conducted hours of surveillance on the Defendant's residence, and attempted personal service no fewer than six (6) times, all unsuccessful. Most of Olson's attempts occurred when the Defendant's car was parked in the driveway and lights were on inside the residence. Olson could hear noise and movement inside the residence, but the Defendant refused to answer the door.
- 9. Through a multitude of service attempts, Olson noted the outside of the Defendant's residence, the Hillside address, covered with security cameras. It is clear the Defendant monitors the property when home and refuses to open the door for anyone. A copy of Olson's Affidavit of Non-Service filed on April 24, 2024 detailing his many service attempts, surveillance and lone telephone conversation with the Defendant, is attached hereto as Exhibit D.
- 7. For the above reasons, and for those detailed in the Sheriff's and Olson's affidavits attached to this motion as exhibits A, C and D, normal service on the Defendant is impractical, now and in the future.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests that this Honorable Court enter an Order granting Service by Special Order of the Court pursuant to statute, and allowing service to be made in a manner consistent with due process, which shall include:

- A. Mailing copies of the summons and complaint by first-class mail and Federal Express 3day shipping and to the Defendant's known address, with proof of the Federal Express delivery presented to the Court as proof of service;
- B. Posting the same on the front door of the Defendant's known address, with photographs of such posting to be presented to the Court as proof of service, and
- C. For such other and further relief as this Honorable Court should determine appropriate.

COMPLAINT AT LAW FOR BREACH OF CONTRACT

NOW COMES PLAINTIFF, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., by and through its attorneys, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., and in support of its COMPLAINT AT LAW against Defendant, ROGER ROMANELLI, states as follows:

- 1. On November 30, 2022, Defendant, ROGER ROMANELLI, ("Defendant") retained the services of Plaintiff Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd. ("Plaintiff") as his attorneys to represent him in a Discrimination case in the Chancery Division in the County Department that, when filed, was captioned as ROGER ROMANELLI v. VILLAGE OF HILLSIDE, Case No.: 2023 CH 02408 in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois. A copy of Retainer Agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 2. Upon retention, Defendant agreed to pay Plaintiff an initial retainer in the amount of \$5,000.00, of which Defendant paid a total of \$5,000.00.
- 3. During the course of Plaintiff's representation of Defendant, Plaintiff provided services and incurred costs that exceeded all retainers paid by Defendant. An Affidavit signed by Plaintiff detailing his services to and costs incurred on behalf of Defendant is attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 4. Defendant has failed to pay the amount due and owing as stated in Exhibit B to Plaintiff.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., prays that this Honorable Court enter a judgment in the amount of \$4,741.07 against Defendant, ROGER ROMANELLI, plus the costs of filing the instant case, and for such other relief that this Honorable Court deems equitable and just.

COUNT I – FRAUD ROGER ROMANELLI

NOW COMES PLAINTIFF, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., (hereinafter "Plaintiff") by and through its attorneys, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., and in support of COUNT II of its COMPLAINT AT LAW against Defendant, ROGER ROMANELLI (hereinafter "ROMANELLI"), alleges and states as follows:

- 5. Plaintiff realleges Paragraphs 1 through 4 as Paragraph 5 of COUNT I as though recited verbatim herein.
- 6. On August 2, 2023, in a scheme to defraud Plaintiff, ROMANELLI issued and delivered check number 4405 (Exhibit C) upon a depository, Republic Bank, for the payment of \$5,000.00 to Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd. (hereinafter, the "check").
- 7. ROMANELLI issued and delivered the check to pay for the labor, services, and costs of Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd.
- In doing so, ROMANELLI represented that the check would be honored by the depository.
- 9. In doing so, ROMANELLI intended Plaintiff to credit his balance in the amount of the check and continue providing labor and services under the retainer agreement.
- 10. Plaintiff relied on ROMANELLI's representation in that it deposited the check.

- 11. At the time of issuance and delivery, however, ROMANELLI knew that the check would not be paid by the depository as he had requested a stop payment on the check.
- 12. As a result, ROMANELLI's account with Plaintiff is still due and owing, and Plaintiff incurred a \$25.00 returned check fee.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, Anthony J. Peraica & Associates, Ltd., prays that this Honorable Court enter a judgment in its favor and against Defendant, ROGER ROMANELLI, for an award of compensatory damages in an amount to be proven at trial, an award of punitive damages, an award of attorney's fees and costs, and for such other and further relief this court deems just and equitable.
